SONOMA COUNTY TIF PROGRAM DRAFT

About the Program: The Sonoma County Board of Supervisors established the Community Investment Fund Program (formerly known as the Advertising Program) in 1986 utilizing Transient Occupancy Tax (Hotel/Motel Tax or Bed Tax) funds. The Transient Occupancy Tax (TOT) is currently charged at a rate of 12% for accommodations at lodging and camping facilities in the unincorporated areas of the county. Of this fund, each District receives a percentage for discretionary projects within each District under something called the Tourism Impact Fund (TIF). These funds are then awarded in grants to nonprofit groups creating improvements or change in their community. Awards are based upon the TIF Policy and Priorities as listed in the next section. For those areas covered by a Municipal Advisory Council (MAC), the TIF policy has been determined by your MAC with community input. For those not covered by a MAC, the application will go the District 5 staff and will follow similar policy and procedures.

Sonoma LRR TIF policy draft

The policy has two parts: applicant eligibility/funding balance along with project priorities

I. Eligibility

- Applicants must be a nonprofit entity.
- Preference will be given to those projects that can demonstrate either matching funds raised to cover part of the costs or financial need. Such matching funds allow us to provide more grants and also demonstrate the community commitment to that particular project.
- Our MAC representatives and staff want to ensure this is easily accessible to all, therefore if your nonprofit requires coaching through the application process, please ask.
- Fairness is important to all the MAC members setting this policy. Therefore, we have set the following guidelines:
 - While we want funds to benefit all towns across the District each year, some years we may have much better proposals from one town that require more funding, and less from another. In this case we will consider multiple years. For example, if one town has a huge project with a lot of support one year, we may have more funding go there and make sure that they get less in the next few years as the other towns get their projects in in future years.
 - We will also consider TOT revenue generation by area as well as tourism impacts by area
 - Funded projects will be transparent on the District 5 TIF Grant program page with multiple years reported.
 - And, of course, projects that affect multiple towns will carry weighting for all towns involved.

II. Funding Priorities

- Tourism Impact Mitigation
- Innovative community enhancement projects
- Communications infrastructure wifi, broadband, emergency communications
- Climate impact mitigation such as EV charging infrastructure
- Permit exemptions to spur business or projects such as vacation exclusion zones, community events, or business support.

The following is a summary of the items the team is focusing on. The team continues to meet weekly and hold monthly meetings with the Ad Hoc and CAO.

- Proposed Sales Tax Measure G: The primary focus continues to be education and outreach. Members of the FSWG and Board of Supervisors are scheduled to provide Measure G briefings to the following groups and organizations:
 - Sonoma City Council (2/3)
 - Sebastopol City Council (2/4)
 - Rohnert Park City Council (2/11)
- The team is continuing to work on Sphere of Influence analysis and recommendations per the request made by the LAFCO Commission and identifying operational next steps should Measure G be approved.
- The team is also working with the County to understand the long term funding needs of CSA 40 areas along with previously funded Fire Service needs.
- The Board of the League of Women's Voters has unanimously voted to support Measure G and the North Bay Leadership Council has decided to endorse Measure G.

We will continue to provide regular updates to this distribution.

Home Repair Loan & Grant - Pilot Program

What does this program do?

Rural Development's Home Repair Loan and Grant Pilot Program increases the maximum amount of assistance available to very-low-income homeowners, as well as improves access to the program in an effort to better assist those in need. This program helps repair, improve and modernize homes in eligible rural areas.

Who may apply for this program?

To qualify you must:

- · Own the home and lot, and occupy the house
- · Be unable to obtain affordable credit elsewhere
- Have a family income below 50% of the area median income.
- For grants, be 62 or older and not be able to repay a loan.

What is an eligible area?

Generally, rural areas with a population less than 35,000 are eligible. Applicants may **check the address** of their home to determine eligibility online.

How much money can I get?

- Maximum loan is \$40,000.
- · Maximum grant is \$10,000.
- Loans and grants can be combined for up to \$50,000 in assistance.

What are the terms of the loan or grant?

- · Loans can be repaid over 20 years at 1% fixed interest rate.
- Full title service and appraisal required for loans more than \$25,000.
- Lots may be subdivided as long as it is modest, typical for the area, and not used for ag or income producing purposes.
- Escrow account and hazard insurance for loans \$15,000 or more.
- · Grants have a lifetime limit of \$10,000.
- Grants must be repaid if the property is sold in less than 3 years.

How may funds be used?

- Loans may be used to repair, improve, or modernize homes or to remove health and safety hazards.
- · Grants must be used to remove health and safety hazards.
- Eligible uses include repairing septic systems, wells, roofs, plumbing, electrical and more.
- Funds may be used for fire prevention safety hazards including removal of brush and trees and necessary home renovations to prevent fires.

Is there a deadline to apply?

Applications are available year round as long as funding is available, and are processed in the order they are received.
